SECOND PHASE MONITORING



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The Open & Distance Learning (ODL) initiative has started its implementation on 13 April 2020. Through the first stage ODL Monitoring Report, Academic Affairs Division (BHEA), Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM) has obtained information related to the implementation of ODL at the faculty level as well as the entire UiTM branch campus.


Through the previous monitoring, the average percentage of students involved with ODL at the faculty level is 96% while at the branch campuses level is 95%. Therefore, the purpose of this monitoring report is to ensure the well implementation and continue the smooth running of this ODL method.

During the first phase, several initiatives have been listed taken by several faculties as well as branch campuses for students who do not have ODL involvement. Therefore, for the second stage report is intended to monitor the implementation of initiatives to increase the percentage of students involved in ODL activities. Apart from that, this matter is very important to avoid the problems of students who drop out of involvement.

Apart from that, for this second phase report, information such as the factor of non-involvement of student in ODL is also identified such as internet access problems, data plan problems, mobile device problems and so on.










STUDENTS INVOLVEMENT IN REPORTED ODL PERIOD




FACTORS OF NO INVOLVEMENT OF STUDENTS IN ODL

Faculty / Campus	Initiatives
Faculty of Film, Theatre & Animation	 Lecturers are given time to contact the students within a wekk before completing the student engagement report. If the students fail to be contacted, the lecturer needs to record the status of the student and the lecturer needs to be proactive to ensure that the status of the missing student can be traced.
Faculty of Mechanical Engineering	 Continue to monitor the students so that no one is left behind. Lecturers are required to report the students involvement after each weekly ODL class according to the ODL method selected in the Google Form at the faculty level. The faculty management holds meeting with lecturers every week to get feedback from the lecturers, as well as reporting by each KPP in JAF Faculty Management Committee meeting which is held weekly.
Arshad Ayub Graduate Business School	 The lecturer record the ODL session conducted and shared the recording with the students. Lecturers use several alternatives to communicate with students who have internet access problems such as email, telephone and Whatsapp.
Faculty of Health Sciences	 Lecturers use more than one platform and not only based on online lectures. Teaching materials and course information have been uploaded into LMS such as Ufuture for students to visit after live streaming session. Teaching materials are provided throughout the whole semester and can be accessed by students before and after lectures. Lecturers contact students who missed live streaming sessions and send notes and voice messages as well as make discussion/exercuses via SMS, Whatsapp, email, phone and telegram. The students also given a period of time to complete ODL activities offline. Relevant Youtube videos and video recordings are shared with students. Students are asked to connect with classmates for 'peer learning'.



INITIATIVE FOR STUDENTS WITHOUT INVOLVEMENT IN ODL

Faculty / Campus	Initiatives
UiTM Pulau Pinang	 Send the learning packages to the student's address in the SIMS record, evenif there is no feedback from the students. Besides, continue to contact students from time to time and friends if they know the latest student information.
UiTM Sabah	 The ODL lectures will be recorded and sent using email to the students. UiTM Sabah is trying to send a lecture post in the form of video to the students. For students who have data plan problems, UiTM Sabah will also provide assistance with an additional RM20 for B40 students for data plan.
UiTM Perak	 Students will be contacted via phone call and email will be used as an alternative platform. Advance slide presentation will be sent to the students who are unable to participate in the video conference. Provides flexibility to communicate in any situation. Whatsapp is the most effective medium for those who do not have strong internet access. Conduct a personal session with the students. ' Provide quizzes at iLearn, do handwritten training work at home – for example find keywords, tabulation from lecture notes, collect practice work then snapshot and upload at iLearn (collected 3 weeks before then end of the semester) or post in Google Classroom (from time to time).
UiTM Pahang	 Students are contacted by lecturers or academic advisors or classleaders either through social media applications, telephone, SMS and email Teaching materials have also been/will be sent to all students involved with various methods to ensure that students do not drop out.
